2010 Boone County Extension Homemakers Quilt Show

Critical Dates/Times

Now until April 14th Pre-registration of quilts accepted at Boone County Extension Office. Entry form can be emailed, mailed, or faxed. Mailed entry forms must be postmarked by April 14, 2010.

All quilts must be pre-registered by April 14th. Note that this differs from last year. No registrations accepted at the door.

April 23th 12:30-5:30pm Drop off quilts at Pavilion. Each quilt must match a pre-registered entry form. Under no circumstances will a quilt be accepted without a pre-registered entry form.

April 24th 9am-5pm Show open in the Pavilion.

April 24th 5:30-7pm Walk-in pickup of items at Pavilion. No early release of quilts—quilts will not be released until one half hour after the show closes.

Category Descriptions

Hand quilted: Quilts designed to be displayed on a bed. The quilting is done by hand.

Machine quilted: Quilts designed to be displayed on a bed. The quilting is done by machine.

Wall Quilt (Includes Miniatures): Quilts designed to be viewed vertically & measuring 60 inches or less on each side.

Mixed & Special Techniques: Quilts constructed with a combination of hand & machine quilting. Garments & accessories. Quilts not fitting any of the other four categories.

Antique: Quilts over 50 years old.

Entry Rules

- If known, all persons involved in making the entry should be listed on the entry form.
- If not an original design, design credit should be given to the source, if known.
- Entry must be made of 3 layers of fabric which is hand or machine quilted. No tied quilts.
- Entries must be identified on the back with name of the exhibitor. Label may be safety-pinned, temporarily basted, or permanently stitched in place. Label may be paper or fabric.
- A sleeve on the top back of the quilt is optional; no quilt will be rejected due to lack of a sleeve.
- The Boone County Extension Homemakers Quilt Show staff reserves the right to reject any unqualified, misrepresented, incomplete, damaged, soiled, poor condition/construction, or other entry deemed unsuitable; the decision of the staff is final.
- There is no limit to the number of entries per person, but number of entries displayed will be at the discretion of the staff & will depend upon number of entries received & available display space.
- Precautions will be taken to maintain a safe environment for the articles entered, but neither the Boone County Extension Office nor the Extension Homemakers Quilt Show will be responsible for the loss or damage of any article. Insurance is the responsibility of the owner.
