Minutes of Meeting:

Wednesday, February 8, 2006, at 7:30 pm at the Old National Bank, Zionsville, Indiana

Discussion:

- Park Tax Letter
  - Status of the letter was reviewed in the meeting. The letter was sent to the Parks Board on 2/5/06. We are still waiting to hear back from them. Jeff Papa will call and try to get on the agenda.
- Brenwick Update
  - Chuck Keraga and Judith Essex summarized their meeting with Keith Lasch of Brenwick Devepolment.
  - Brenwick is planning to install sidewalks and walking paths throughout their development.
  - A key pathway that they have planned coincides with the boards' plans to install a trail from the old railroad southwest to Royal Run. Brenwick Development would install about 1/3 of the total length of the pathway that is planned.
  - Brenwick also plans to install a portion of the rail trail. The board felt that the entire .8 mile length of the trail should be installed by the developer and the school system.
  - Both Keith Lasch of Brenwick Development and Bob Boswick of the Zionsville Community School Corporation need to be contracted to discuss how this can be accomplished.
- Indianapolis Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO)
  - Chuck Keraga reported on the meeting of the MPO of Tuesday, February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2006.
  - The MPO is interested in getting all of the different organizations together to coordinate all efforts, and work together to create a region-wide network of interconnecting trails.
  - Judith Essex agreed to send Rachel Uthe, of Storrow Kinsella Associates, two copies of the Eagle Township Parks Board Plan 2005-2009 Plan.
  - The MPO will contact, via e-mail, all board members to announce future meetings of the organization.
- Temporary Power Line Trail Name
  - The Board voted unanimously to refer to the power line trail as the Pratt Trail, after Ray Pratt, who first envisioned it.
  - The trail is planned to run from the proposed rail trail extension, southwest from where the electrical substation is located to royal Run.
- Future Meetings
  - The Board voted unanimously to cancel future meetings only in cases of extreme emergency.
- Jeff Papa agreed to invite the Zionsville Parks board to a future meeting.
