
This correspondence serves to follow up to your letter dated April 30, 2007, to Rob Guest, Worth Township Trustee, regarding the fire protection and emergency medical services provided for under the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into by and between Worth Township and Union Township (the "Interlocal Agreement").

As you requested, we are responding to your letter in writing to notify you that Worth Township does not agree to a termination of the Interlocal Agreement. Therefore, pursuant to Section 2 of the Interlocal Agreement, the term of the Agreement shall continue.

Rob has suggested that we meet with you and the Union Township Trustee to discuss any questions that your client may have at this point. Worth Township has relied on the Interlocal Agreement in planning its operations and budget, so naturally the parties' rights and obligations under the Interlocal Agreement are important for the Township.
