



2010 Baseball/Softball Division Alignment



(NOTE: Birth date determines division age eligibility as of 4/30/10 for Baseball & 12/31/09 for Softball)

Baseball

Junior/Senior/Big League

Junior/Senior and Big League divisions are played on full-size, 60' pitching and 90' base path fields and include players ages 13 through 18. The Little League International rules allow flexibility in assigned ages to divisions based on registration age distribution. However, age breakdown typically follows Juniors (13/14), Seniors (15/16) and Big League (17/18.)

Major

Major division is the top level of competition played on a 46' pitching/60' base path field. The Major division is open for players ages 12, 11 and 10 years old and team rosters are selected by a Manager draft. All 12 year old players are required by rule to play in the Major division. The 11 and 10 year old players in the Major division must be drafted by the Managers. The 11 and 10 year old players registering to play in Majors but not drafted will be included in the Minor AAA division draft.

Minor AAA

Minor AAA division is the second level of competition for player-pitch baseball on a 46' pitching/60' base path field. The Minor AAA division is open for players ages 11, 10 and 9 years old and team rosters are selected by a Manager draft. The 9 year old players registering to play in Majors but not drafted will be included in the Minor AA division draft.

Minor AA

Minor AA division is the first level of competition for player-pitch baseball on a 46' pitching/60' base path field. The Minor AA division is open for players ages 10 and 9 years old and team rosters are selected by a Manager draft. Player movement from Rookie divisions will be based only on SAFETY reasons, not simply by parent request.

Rookie

Rookie divisions are coach-pitch and instructional in nature. Modified baseball rules are taught and followed with coaches pitching from 40-45'. Rookie divisions are divided into two leagues by age, with player's age 8 in one league and player's age 7 and 6 in the other. Player movement between leagues will be based only on SAFETY reasons, not simply by parent request. Players age 6 MUST have one year of tee-ball experience. Team rosters are established by league officials.

Softball

Junior/Senior

Junior and Senior divisions are the top level of competition with a 12" softball. These divisions are open to players ages 13 through 16, with Junior's typically including player's ages 13 and 14 and Senior's including player's ages 15 and 16.

Major

Major division is the second level of competition played with a 12" softball. The Major division is open for player's age 12 and 11 years old and team rosters are selected by a Manager draft. All 12 year old players are required by rule to play in the Major division. Player movement between leagues will be based only on SAFETY reasons, not simply by parent request.

Minor

Minor division is the first level of competition for player-pitch played with a 11" softball. The Minor division is open for players ages 10, 9 and 8 years old and team rosters are selected by a Manager draft. Players age 8 not selected in the Manager draft will be included in the team selection for the Rookie division.

Rookie

Rookie division is coach-pitch and instructional in nature. Modified softball rules are taught and followed. Team rosters are established by league officials.

All-Star Eligibility Considering Division Realignment

A player can be selected to an all-star team for an age level higher than their actual Little League age. However, even if a player plays in a division above their age level, they can still be selected to their age level team. As an example, a 10-year-old who registers and is drafted to play in the Major division, but is not selected for either the all-star teams for ages 12 or 11, CAN be selected for the 10-year-old all-star team.
